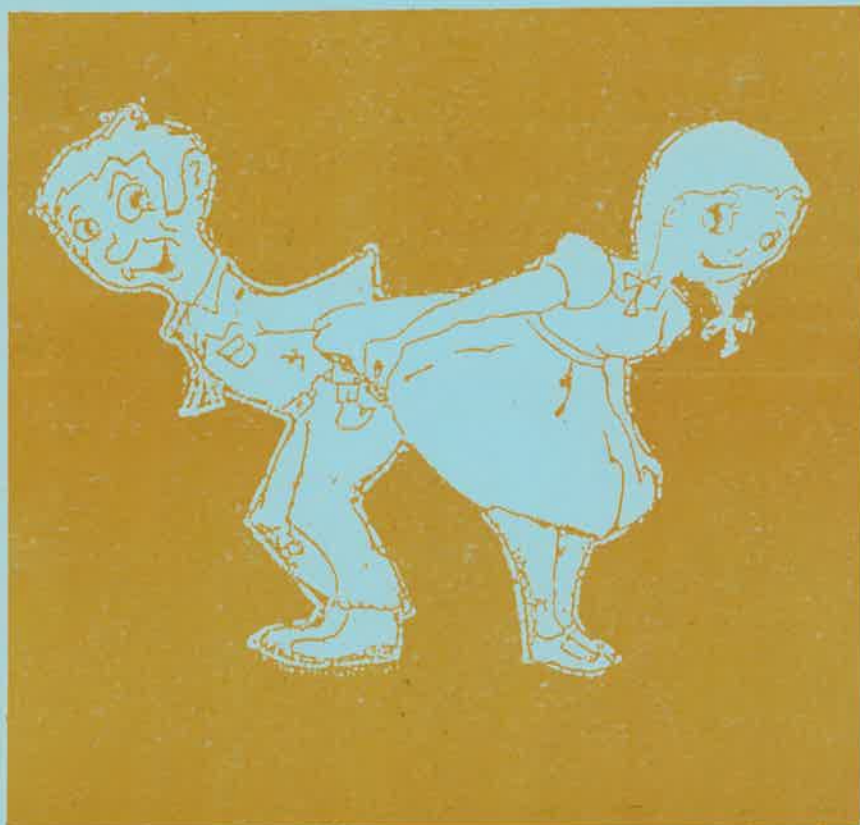

With happiness, with smiles, with pain and tears,

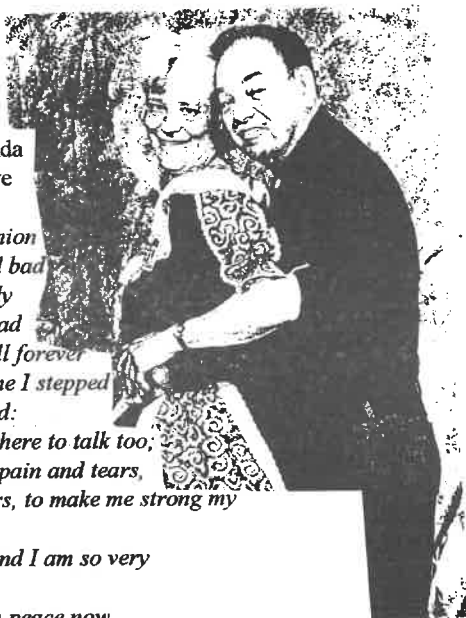
