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**Millard Fillmore McKinney**, 81, of Grants Pass, died Tuesday, December 4, 2001 at Royale Gardens Health and Rehabilitation Center.

He was born December 28, 1919 in Astoria, Oregon. In 1938 he graduated from Alameda High School in Alameda, California. At age 15 he met the former June P. Rasmussen and married on December 10, 1942 in Key West, Florida. For 20 years he was in the Navy and served in WW II and the Korean War. During WW II he was on two ships that were sunk in two days in the South Seas. A book, "Pawns of War" was written about this experience. For 19 years he worked for Friden Business Machines and for Singer Computer Division for four years. He and his wife moved to Grants Pass from San Jose, California in June of 1999.

He enjoyed his computer and helping others. He and June were avid square and round dancers for many years. They had their own round dance club called "Diamond Rounds". He was the cuer for the Bay Area "B Sharps". He and June traveled around the USA and the world with various dancing groups.

He was President of "The Villages", an adult community in San Jose, California. He was also President and lifetime member of the Northern California Round Dancers Association and a 59 year member of the Free and Accepted Masons of California.

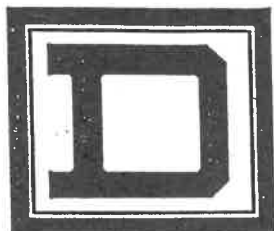

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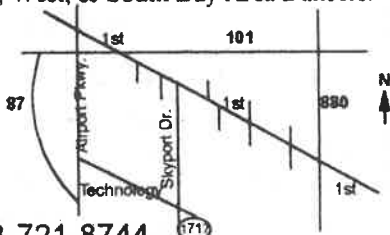
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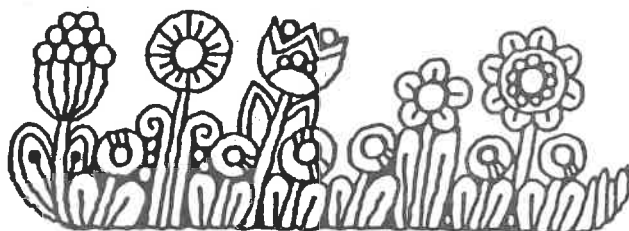
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### **DISTRICT I**

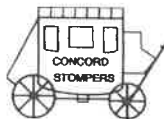

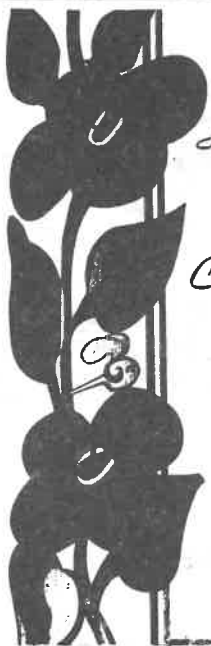
