In Memory

Nathan Lee Bliss

1940 – 2002

Our good friend and square dance caller, Nate Bliss, passed away on November 6, 2002.

Nate was a great caller, and, more importantly, a great friend. He was keenly interested in doing things to promote square dancing and not let the activity die. His easy going demeanor made him fun to be around.

Nate gave a lot to the Square Dance Callers Association of Northern California. He was genuinely interested in moving the Association forward. He spent countless hours in developing and maintaining the SDCANC web site pages. Nate shared new ideas about what could be done almost every week.

Nate was a mentor for other callers. New and aspiring callers looked up to Nate for guidance and wisdom from an experienced and accomplished professional. Nate inspired callers to be the best they could be. He also introduced the love of square dancing to thousands of beginners.

Nate's calling career spanned 39 years, starting in his military days where he took over calling duties from his CO who was being transferred. Nate called full-time for ten years in the San Bernadino Valley. Later he became resident caller at parks in Tucson, Arizona and Mission Bell, Texas. Nate and Debi settled in Northern California in 1983. Nate was well-known as a talented caller with a smooth voice, traveling throughout the United States, Canada, Germany, Saudi Arabia and Australia. At home he called regularly for the Adobe Squares in Petaluma and the Twin City Steppers in Fairfield.

Nate served in the United States Air Force from 1959 until 1965. During his tenure he flew over 100 missions in Vietnam.

Recently, Nate headed the NCSDA Chairman's Ball, coordinating several callers and cuers for the event. He served as a best man to another caller in his wedding. And he was always available for any event or idea that would promote square dancing.

Nate is survived by his wife, Debi, sons Nathan Lee Bliss, Jr. of Lawrence, Kansas and Kevin Bliss of Lexington, South Carolina, and mother Marjorie Frazer of Marion, New York, and grandchildren Ashley, Joshua, Adam, Hunter and Katie.



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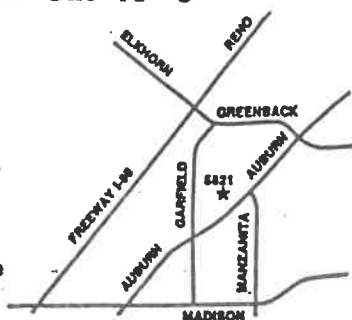
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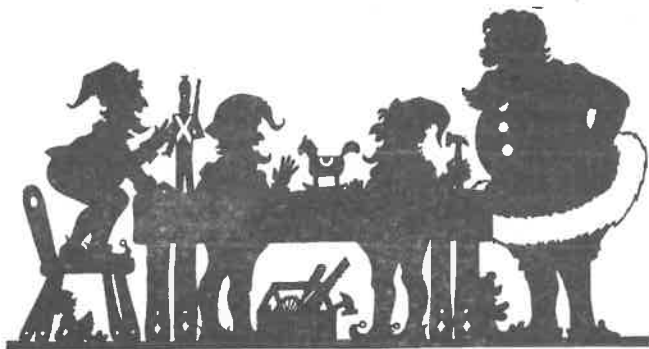
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DISTRICT I
