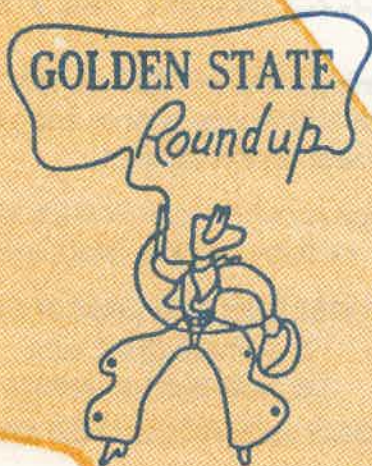

Pur caller **KEITH FERGUSON** recently wrote an informative newsletter article on the evolution of square dance calls. Below is an excerpt: In the days of traditional square dancing, standardization and common terminology were not very important. Dancers were taught complete dances and questions about moves could be answered during the "walk-through." Dancers and callers did not travel as much, and local dance variations didn't really matter. With the advent of Modern Western Square Dancing during the 1950's, this all changed. The emphasis was on variety and, at least to some extent, surprise. The walk-through was a thing of the past. Dancers were expected to be familiar with a variety of moves, and in turn expected these to be called in random order. By the early 1970's chaos had arrived! Dancers in different areas of the country learned different moves, and sometimes used the same names for completely different calls. If you learned to dance in Mountain View, you might not be able to dance in Texas, or perhaps even in Los Angeles! "Sets in Order" magazine tried to bring order to square dancing by publishing suggested lists of calls for all dancers to know and Callerlab was born. One of its first (and most significant) accomplishments was to achieve agreement on a number of dance "programs." Each program included both a clear list of calls making up the program and very specific definitions for each call. These Callerlab Programs are used today by the vast majority of all Modern Western Square Dancers. Today these programs consist of Mainstream, Plus, two levels of Advanced, and several levels of Challenge.

Each program includes all of the calls in the lower programs -- for example, the Plus Program includes all of the Mainstream calls plus additional calls. Every two years, Callerlab committees review each program and may adjust the content. **THOUGHTS FOR THE MONTH:** The most beautiful stones have been tossed by the wind and washed by the waters & polished to brilliance by life's strongest storm. 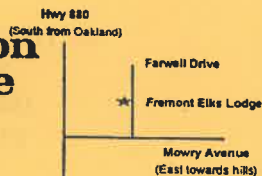
