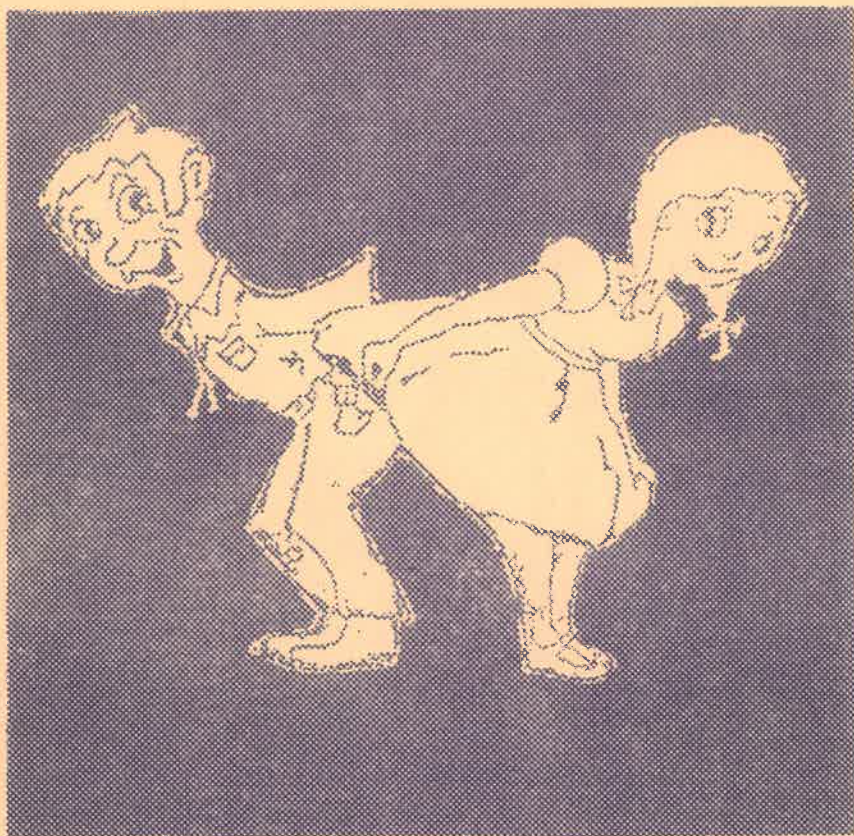

MINKIN TO SUCCEED HOBAUGH AT THE BUZZIN' BOOTS CLUB

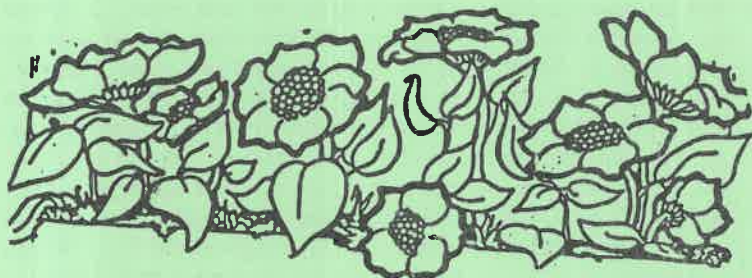
