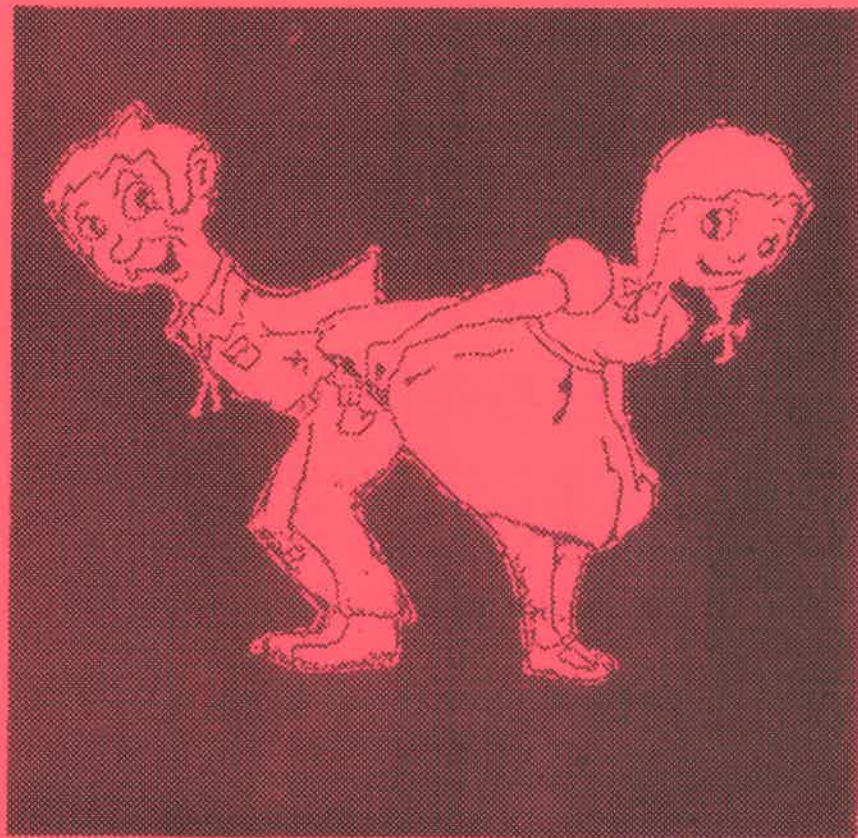

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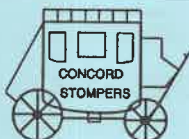

CALIFORNIA FRIENDSHIP PROGRAM

How much do you know about California Square Dance Council's Friendship Program? I bet some of you dancers in California have never heard of it. The program was started during the '90's to award dancers for going to different festivals and dancing throughout the state of California. In doing so, they made new friendships in the process.

All you need to do is get one of the Friendship Program forms from you Affiliate (NCSDA). Take it with you to nine different Affiliate Festivals, plus one California State Convention. Have the form signed by a Festival Committee member and dated. You must dance at least one tip at each event. The Festivals are listed on the back of the form and no duplications are allowed. There is no time limit for completing the form.

There is also a Youth Program that requires, they only go to four Festivals plus one State Convention. The Handicapable dancers have a program that only requires they attend two Festivals plus one State Convention. Both programs have their own form.

When you complete the form, turn it in to your Affiliate (NCSDA) President and they will see that it is turned in to Council. California square Dance Council will present each dancer completing the program a Certificate and a badge swinger. You can go through the program as many times as you would like.

Patrick and I heard about this program in the '90's and we started working on our first one right away. In November of 2004 we will receive our tenth swinger. This has been a lot of fun and travel throughout this great state of California. We have made a lot of friends along the way. Try this yourself and see how many new friends you can make along the way.

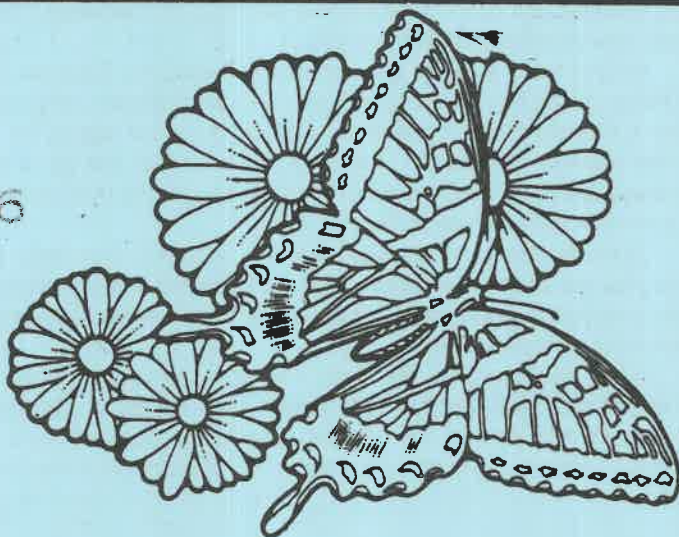
